## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Sexual Assault Awareness Month calls attention to the fact that sexual violence impacts every

person in every community in Minnesota, and the many voices of victims and survivors of sexual

violence must be supported and heard; and

WHEREAS: Community advocates have spent decades working to create a safe and supportive environment for

victims and survivors, and victims and survivors need continued care and resources; and

WHEREAS: Every victim's and survivor's response are unique, and every victim and survivor have the right to

receive support and understanding from friends, families, and their communities; as well as from

medical, legal, social services, and criminal justice systems; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's Indigenous, transgender, women, and youth populations are among the communities

most heavily affected by sexual violence; and

WHEREAS: Many victims continue to face challenges in finding appropriate or quality services; and

WHEREAS: Sexism, racism, heterosexism, classism, ableism, religious oppression, and ageism are among the

root causes of sexual violence; and

WHEREAS: Every child deserves to grow up in an environment that supports their ability to reach their full

potential and where sexual violence is not tolerated; and

WHEREAS: A growing number of Minnesotan leaders are committed to sexual violence prevention, and all

Minnesotans must commit our time, efforts, and resources to prevent and respond to sexual

violence in our communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of April 2021, as:
