## Proclamation

WHEREAS: Jorge Mario Bergoglio was born in Buenos Aires, Argentina, on December 17, 1936. When

he was elected Pope in 2013, he chose the name Pope Francis in honor of St. Francis of

Assisi, who was a servant to poor and destitute; and

WHEREAS: Pope Francis served as pope of the Roman Catholic Church from 2013 to 2025 and made

history as the first Latin American Pope; and

WHEREAS: Pope Francis dedicated his life to the Catholic Church and was deeply loved by his

diocese; he was known for his humility and advised his priests to show mercy and keep their doors open to everyone, saying "my people are poor and I am one of them"; and

WHEREAS: Pope Francis was a champion of progressive causes, was outspoken in his support of the

world's poor and the dispossessed, championed the plight of migrants across the globe, was known for his environmental activism and advocacy for peace, and was the first

pope to authorize the blessings of same-sex couples; and

WHEREAS: Named Person of the Year by Time Magazine in 2013, Pope Francis led with a focus on

reform, addressing questions and issues of death, social justice, ecology, wealth

inequality, materialism, and the role of the family; and

WHEREAS: Pope Francis died on April 21, 2025, at the age of 88; and

WHEREAS: Pope Francis led with humility, courage, and love, demanding justice for the poor and

other marginalized communities, while serving as a spiritual leader for millions around the world. His courageous leadership has positively impacted countless lives, and his

work will not be forgotten.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota until the day of interment in honor and remembrance of Pope Francis.
