- WHEREAS: Conservation Officer Wynn was an outstanding Conservation Officer, who was admired and respected by his colleagues, and served with dignity and pride; and
- WHEREAS: Conservation Officer Wynn was passionate about camping, fishing, and hunting, and sharing those outdoor experiences with family and friends; he fulfilled his dream of becoming a Conservation Officer and was fiercely loyal to his law enforcement family; and
- WHEREAS: Conservation Officer Wynn died in the line of duty on Friday, April 19; and
- WHEREAS: Conservation Officer Wynn is survived by his wife, Heather Wynn; children, Sophie and EJ; parents, Eugene Sr. and Linda Wynn.; and many nieces, nephews and other relatives and friends; and
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes Conservation Officer Wynn for his dedicated service to, and sacrifice for, his fellow citizens with its deepest gratitude, and all thoughts and prayers are with his family, friends, and entire community.
