Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Registered Nurse Debra K. Schott dedicated the majority of her time providing emergency medical care to residents of Minnesota. Flight Nurse Schott spent the last 15 years working as a Critical Care Nurse for North Memorial Health Care; and
- WHEREAS: Flight Nurse Schott was an outstanding Nurse who was respected and admired by her colleagues and served the public with dignity and pride as a Flight Nurse; and
- WHEREAS: Flight Nurse Schott was passionate about traveling, working in her garden, and scenic photography. She was also passionate about emergency care, starting as a volunteer EMT while she worked towards her degree in nursing; and
- WHEREAS: North Memorial Health Care Flight Nurse Debra Schott died while on duty on Friday, June 28th; and
- WHEREAS: Flight Nurse Schott is survived by her husband Gary L. Schott; daughter Kristie Collins; son Craig Hatlestad; two grandchildren, Hailee Collins and Bryce Hatlestad; mother Norma Olson; Brother Timothy Olson; and many other friends and family. She was preceded in death by her father Robert Olson and son Jeffrey Hatlestad.
- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota recognizes Flight Nurse Schott for her dedicated services to, and sacrifice for, her fellow citizens with its deepest gratitude, and all thoughts and prayers are with her family, friends, and entire community.
