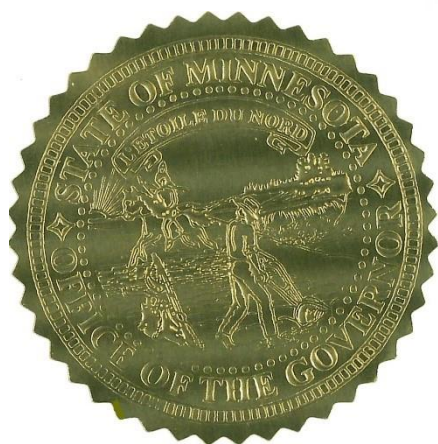

WHEREAS: Sergeant Wallin was killed in the line of duty as a Fargo Police Officer on Friday, July 14, 2023, in Fargo, North Dakota; and

WHEREAS: Sergeant Wallin is survived by his father, Jeffrey Paul Wallin, mother, Amy Danielle Wallin, his brother, Brady Wallin, grandparents John and Carolee Wallin and Jerry and Deborah Shuler, and his fiancée, Winter Malone; and

WHEREAS: With its deepest gratitude, the State of Minnesota recognizes Sergeant Wallin for his dedicated service to, and sacrifice for, his fellow Minnesotans and North Dakotans, and our thoughts and prayers are with his family, friends, and community.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff immediately at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota, until sunset on Saturday, July 22, 2023, in honor and remembrance of Sergeant Jake Wallin.
