Proclamation

WHEREAS: On Saturday, August 3 and Sunday, August 4, 2019 terrible acts of violence were perpetrated against innocent victims in El Paso, Texas and Dayton, Ohio; and

WHEREAS: The victims and their families deserve our honor, respect, and remembrance; and

WHEREAS: The President of the United States of America has lowered United States flags at all public buildings, grounds, and military posts of the Federal Government until sunset on Thursday, August 8, 2019.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota immediately until sunset on Thursday, August 8, 2019, in memory of the victims of this tragedy.
