Proclamation

WHEREAS: September 11, 2025, marks the 24th anniversary of the terrorist attacks against the

United States of America in which thousands of innocent people were killed and injured;

and

WHEREAS: Police officers, fire and rescue personnel, first responders, and the American people

demonstrated extraordinary bravery in the wake of these attacks; and

WHEREAS: On December 18, 2001, Congress designated September 11 of each year as Patriot Day, and

on April 21, 2009, Congress requested this day also be observed as National Day of

Service and Remembrance; and

WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota have set aside this day to honor, remember, and mourn the

innocent victims of the terrorist attacks on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS: September 11, 2025, is nationally proclaimed as Patriot Day and National Day of Service

and Remembrance. This day invites people across the nation to remember those we lost, honor those who demonstrated bravery in the face of terrorism, and recognize the heroes

who continue to protect our nation every day.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, September 11, 2025, as:

PATRIOT DAY

in the State of Minnesota and do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags to be flown at half-staff at all state buildings in the State of Minnesota from sunrise on Wednesday, September 11, through sunset on Sunday, September 14, as a mark of respect for the victims of the September 11, 2001 terrorist attacks and the victims of the Annunciation Catholic School shooting.
