Proclamation

WHEREAS: The establishment of the Honorary Consulate of Brazil in Minnesota, which serves our Brazilian community and supports the strengthening the ties between Brazil and Minnesota, along with the community creation of the Brazil Minnesota Chamber of Commerce, is an acknowledgment of the important relationship between Minnesota and Brazil; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota greatly values the increasing importance of the trade relationship between Minnesota and Brazil, along with the growing Brazilian population in Minnesota; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota recognizes the diverse and abundant prospects to advance mutually beneficial economic, social, cultural, and educational exchanges between Minnesota and Brazil.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Thursday, September 30, 2021, as:

BRAZIL DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
