Proclamation

WHEREAS: Minnesota's school nutrition professionals, early care providers, farmers, producers, and food

system workforce are recognized and celebrated for their leadership ensuring that children in

Minnesota are nourished and ready to learn; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's schools and early care providers play a vital role in shaping children's nutrition and

fostering lifelong healthy eating habits. In 2023, Minnesota passed the Free School Meals for Kids

Program, ensuring every student has access to fresh, quality food; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota is home to many vibrant, small and mid-sized family farms that supply local schools,

early cares, and markets with fresh, local produce; and

WHEREAS: Individuals who identify as Black, Indigenous, Latine, people of color, and Immigrants make up a

significant portion of our food system workforce and play a significant role in ensuring our access

to food; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota's school nutrition professionals, early care providers, farmers, and farm workers are

recognized and celebrated for their leadership in ensuring that children in Minnesota are

nourished and ready to learn; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota relies on collaborations with state agencies and community partners to achieve

common goals, promote equity and inclusion, ensure thriving communities, and uplift children and

families; and

WHEREAS: Farm to School and Early Care empowers children and their families to make informed food

choices, strengthens the local economy, and contributes to vibrant communities; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota supports children, school nutrition professionals, early care providers, farmers,

producers, and food system workforce, and recognizes the critical importance of access to fresh

food.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, TIM WALZ, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim October 2025 as:

FARM TO KIDS MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
