partner, occurring on average to one in three women in Minnesota and across the nation; and

WHEREAS: $Domestic\ violence\ programs\ across\ the\ State\ provide\ support\ and\ resources\ to\ over\ 55,000\ victims\ and$

survivors at any one time to ensure their safety; and

WHEREAS: Barriers, including systemic racial disparities, impact victims and survivors of domestic violence. Everyone experiencing violence should be able to access the help and support they need; and

WHEREAS: Domestic violence programs serve survivors of all immigrant statuses because no one should be forced to

choose between staying in an abusive relationship and finding safety; and

WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota acknowledges the tireless work and dedication that advocacy groups and organizations

have committed to ensuring the State's laws and practices protect and empower victims and survivors of

WHEREAS: Survivors must be believed and supported in their search for justice, which empowers more survivors to come

forward and prevent further harm; and

WHEREAS: Safe and affordable housing is a top priority and a human right as domestic violence continues to be a leading

cause of homelessness for women, and housing insecurity is one of the main barriers preventing victims and

survivors of domestic violence from seeking help and safety; and

WHEREAS: During the COVID-19 pandemic, survivors were increasingly isolated and stressed, putting them at greater risk

of domestic violence; and

WHEREAS: Community collaboration ensures the safety of victims and survivors in Minnesota. Preventing violence before

it begins and transforming behavior after violence has occurred is critical to our shared goal of a violence-free
