Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Senior Nutrition services were established in Minnesota through the Older Americans Act in October 1973; and
- WHEREAS: For 40 years, volunteers have served millions of Senior Nutrition service meals to thousands of Minnesota seniors; and
- WHEREAS: Senior Nutrition services provide nutritious meals as a critical component of seniors living within a community with the greatest possible independence; and
- WHEREAS: Senior Nutrition sites serve as a place for seniors to congregate and socialize, access resources, volunteer, and participate in recreational activities; and
- WHEREAS: Senior Nutrition services provide home-delivered meals to homebound individuals, helping meet nutritional needs, offering health and safety checks, and providing socialization; and
- WHEREAS: Senior Nutrition services are vital to helping Minnesota seniors live healthy and independent lives in their communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim the month of October 2013, as:

SENIOR NUTRITION MONTH

in the State of Minnesota.
