# Proclamation

WHEREAS: Nancy Reagan was former First Lady of the United States from 1981-1989; and

WHEREAS: Nancy Reagan was an extraordinary First Lady and humanitarian and dedicated her life to public service; leading the "Just Say No" anti-drug campaign and stem cell research; and

WHEREAS: With the passing of Nancy Regan, President Obama has ordered American flags at all government buildings and facilities be flown at half-staff beginning immediately as a mark of respect for the memory of Nancy Reagan; and

WHEREAS: In concurrence with the President's order and in remembrance of Nancy Reagan and her many contributions, Governor Dayton has ordered the American and Minnesota flags at state buildings and facilities also be flown at half-staff beginning immediately.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota immediately through the day of interment, in memory of Nancy Reagan.
