Proclamation

WHEREAS: On Sunday, July 17, 2016, a violent attack was perpetrated against the police officers and people of Baton Rouge, Louisiana; and

WHEREAS: The victims and their families deserve our honor, respect, and remembrance; and

WHEREAS: The President of the United States of America has lowered United States flags at all public buildings, grounds, and military posts of the Federal Government until sunset on Friday, July 22, 2016.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby order all United States flags and Minnesota flags be flown at half-staff at all state and federal buildings in the State of Minnesota immediately, until sunset on Friday, July 22, 2016, in memory of the victims of this tragedy.
