Proclamation

WHEREAS: Area Neighbors Giving Elderly Live-In Services (ANGELS) was established in 2004 as a community-based program of volunteers within the McGregor area, offering assistance to help seniors continue living in their homes as long as possible with independence and dignity; and

WHEREAS: ANGELS helps seniors by providing transportation, visits, and telephone calls; assisting with minor home repairs, yard work, and snow removal; assisting with medical or business correspondence; sponsoring community education/workshops for seniors and caregivers; and connecting seniors with other community resources and services; and

WHEREAS: ANGELS' volunteer base of 171 caring individuals provide services to 98 area seniors on a monthly basis; and

WHEREAS: During the last ten years, ANGELS volunteers have assisted 534 seniors; and

WHEREAS: August 18, 2014, marks the 10th Anniversary of ANGELS of McGregor and it is important to recognize the organization's ongoing services.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Monday, August 18, 2014, as:

ANGELS OF MCGREGOR DAY

in the State of Minnesota.
