WHEREAS: Goalie Noora Raty earned the title of Most Outstanding Player of the 2013 Frozen Four, with an impressive 46 saves; and forward Amanda Kessel was honored with the Patty Kazmaier Memorial Award for her incredible 100-point season; and

WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Women's Hockey Team has the distinction of being the 2013 NCAA Division I Champions; and

WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Women's Hockey Team has the added distinction of being the first undefeated team in the history of NCAA Women's Hockey; and

WHEREAS: Led by Coach Brad Frost, the Gopher Women demonstrated extraordinary determination, skill, and perseverance on their way to the University's fourth National Championship in Women's Hockey and its second, consecutive national victory; and

WHEREAS: The University of Minnesota Women's Hockey Team serves as a source of great pride for all people in the State of Minnesota.
