- WHEREAS: The State of Minnesota values the diversity of its people; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota value privacy, fairness, acceptance, and understanding amongst all citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community of Minnesota has contributed to the quality of life and success of this state; and
- WHEREAS: There is cause to celebrate the past success of the movement to gain equality for all citizens regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity; and
- WHEREAS: The struggle for human rights in Minnesota and the United States must continue in order to assure that all lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans can be open, honest, and safe at home, work, and in the community; and
- WHEREAS: The Human Rights Campaign is celebrating its 23rd Annual Minnesota Gala Dinner on September 8th, 2012.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim September 8, 2012 as:
