Proclamation

WHEREAS: Good oral health is critical to the overall health and wellbeing of all Minnesotans; and

WHEREAS: The Minnesota Mission of Mercy was established in 2012 to provide free dental care to children and adults of underserved populations, especially those with dental infections and pain; and

WHEREAS: Minnesota Mission of Mercy raises awareness of the barriers to accessing dental care faced by low-income children and adults; and

WHEREAS: Because the power of a beautiful, healthy smile can change lives, more than 1,000 dental professionals and volunteers from across Minnesota will gather in Bemidji, Minnesota, June 14 – 15, 2013, to provide free dental care and oral health education to patients in need; and

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 14, 2013, as:
