Proclamation

WHEREAS: The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Minnesota is an Alumni Council service organization committed to community service, mentoring, providing scholarships to young people, academic achievement, health services outreach, and tackling civil rights issues; and

WHEREAS: Alpha Kappa Alpha, Alpha Phi Alpha, Zeta Phi Beta, Iota Phi Theta, Sigma Gamma Rho, and Phi Beta Sigma sororities and fraternities recognize their respective organizations as instruments for enriching and engaging their communities beyond college graduation by providing mental stimulation and support through interaction with community leaders, state legislators, friends, and associates; and

WHEREAS: The National Pan-Hellenic Council of Minnesota and its member service organizations focus on strategies to motivate social and economic change through civic engagement; and

WHEREAS: National Pan-Hellenic Council of Minnesota Day at the State Capitol is a non-partisan event, where members of the African American community are encouraged to engage in meaningful dialogue with legislators, constitutional officers, and members of the judiciary regarding issues which disproportionately affect them in the State of Minnesota.
