- WHEREAS: The people of Minnesota value freedom, privacy, fairness, acceptance, and understanding amongst all citizens; and
- WHEREAS: The lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender community of Minnesota contribute to the quality of life and success of this state; and
- WHEREAS: There is cause to celebrate the past year's success of the movement to gain equality for citizens regardless of their sexual orientation or gender identity; and
- WHEREAS: The struggle for human rights in Minnesota and the United States must continue in order to assure that all lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender Americans can be open, honest, and safe at home, work, and in the community; and
- WHEREAS: The Human Rights Campaign is celebrating its 24th Annual Minnesota Gala Dinner on Saturday, September 21, 2013.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Saturday, September 21, 2013, as:
