Proclamation

- WHEREAS: Our country's military – past, present, and fallen – need to be remembered, recognized, and honored for their sacrifices for our freedom; and
- WHEREAS: The Nation of Patriots has initiated a nationwide effort in which one United States flag will travel throughout the country for 100 days, in honor and respect of all United States service members; and
- WHEREAS: On Tuesday, September 1, 2015, members of the Eden Prairie Harley Davidson owners group will deliver the flag to Bergdale Harley Davidson in Albert Lea, Minnesota; and
- WHEREAS: The Honor Guard, comprised of veterans from the American Legion Post 56, Veterans of Foreign Wars and the Albert Lea Armory, will receive the flag and fold it for display; and
- WHEREAS: On Wednesday, September 2, 2015, riders from the Albert Lea, Minnesota area will gather at Bergdale Harley Davidson and escort the flag to its next scheduled stop, Zylstra Harvey Davidson in Ames, Iowa; and
- WHEREAS: The Nation of Patriots realizes the importance of recognizing our country's heroes – the mothers, fathers, sons, and daughters – who have bravely gone into combat, and make crucial sacrifices so that each of us can experience another day of freedom.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, MARK DAYTON, Governor of Minnesota, do hereby proclaim Tuesday, September 1, 2015, as:

in the State of Minnesota.
