The Capitol Area Library Consortium (CALCO) is a group of libraries and information centers serving the executive, legislative, and judicial branches of Minnesota state government and the citizens of Minnesota. CALCO welcomes other libraries, organizations, and individuals as associate members, who may attend meetings and educational programs.

CALCO was formed in 1973 to encourage cooperation among the government libraries. Today CALCO libraries belong to a statewide on-line library catalog (MnPALS), share information resources among CALCO libraries and statewide through Minitex, provide Internet guidance and leadership, cooperate in acquiring federal depository documents and other materials, participate in long range planning, advise on the development of state government libraries, and offer continuing education programs.

This directory identifies the member libraries of CALCO, their staff, and their public services policies. It also provides contact information for associate members. We hope that this directory will help to distribute Minnesota state government information to the library community and the citizens of Minnesota.

We offer historical collections of Minnesota statutes, laws, rules, and Attorney General opinions.

BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF COLLECTION

The MHS Library contains a variety of published and unpublished sources about Minnesota life and people, in many different formats. Highlights include a major collection of Minnesota publications, works on North American history, local history, and a rich genealogy collection. The manuscript collections document all aspects of Minnesota life through letters, diaries, and financial and business records. The State Archives are the official and historic records of the territory and state. The records of the Great Northern and Northern Pacific railway companies are a major collection of unpublished materials. The most complete set of Minnesota newspapers available, 500,000 photographs about Minnesota, prints, tapes, three-dimensional objects, paintings, and an extensive collection of plat books, atlases, and printed flat maps round out the collection.
