

St Cloud Area Schools Out of School Suspensions: January-Mid March 2020

Provided below is the 2019-20 out of school suspension data for District 742. Due to the shift from in-person to distance learning that took place during the middle of March, this data only reflects 2 ½ months (i.e., January- March 13, 2020). As a comparison, the 2017-18 and 2018-19 out of school suspension data with the same time parameters is also included.

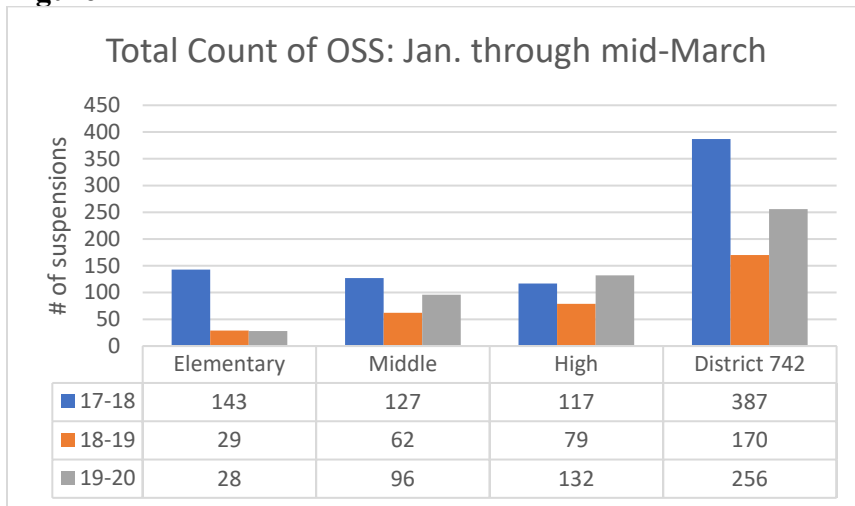


Figure 1 indicates the total count of out of school suspensions that occurred between January and the middle of March for the identified school years. This information is disaggregated by grade level (i.e., elementary, middle, and high) and is also provided for the district overall.

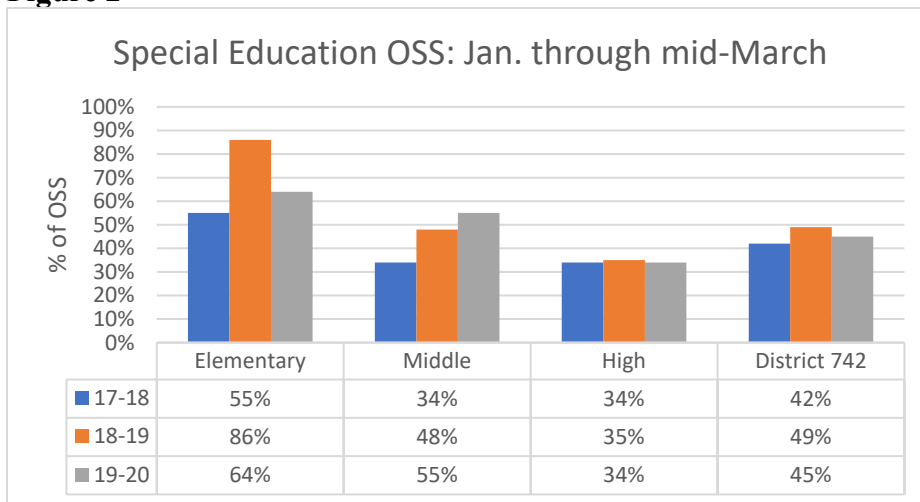
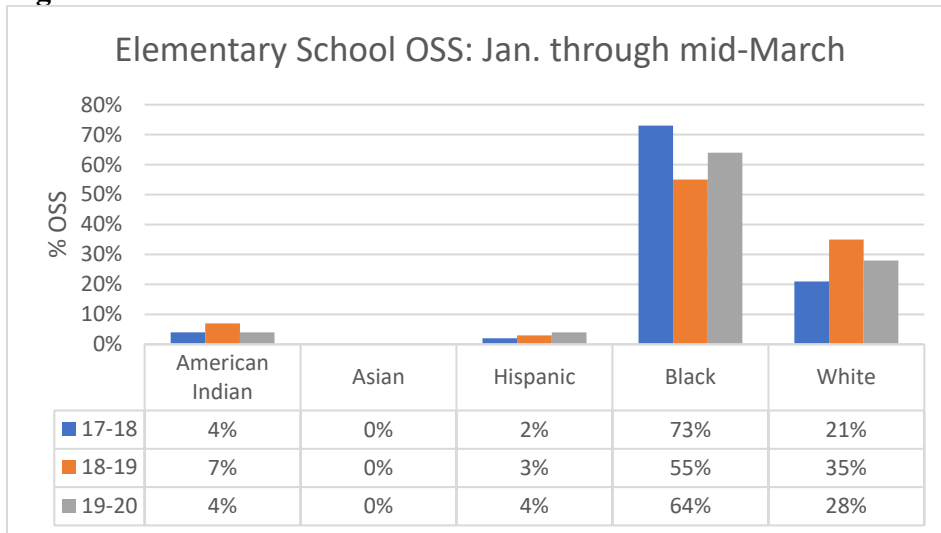


Figure 2 shows the percentage of out of school suspensions that involved students identified for special education services. For example, from January to mid-March of the 2019-20 academic year, 34% of the out of school suspensions at the high school level involved a SPED student.

Figures 3-5 disaggregate the out of school suspension data by race for each of the specified grade levels. For example, Figure 3 indicates that out of all the elementary-level suspensions from January through mid-March of the 2019-20 school year, 64% were given to Black students, 28% were given to White students, 4% to American Indian students and 4% to Hispanic students.

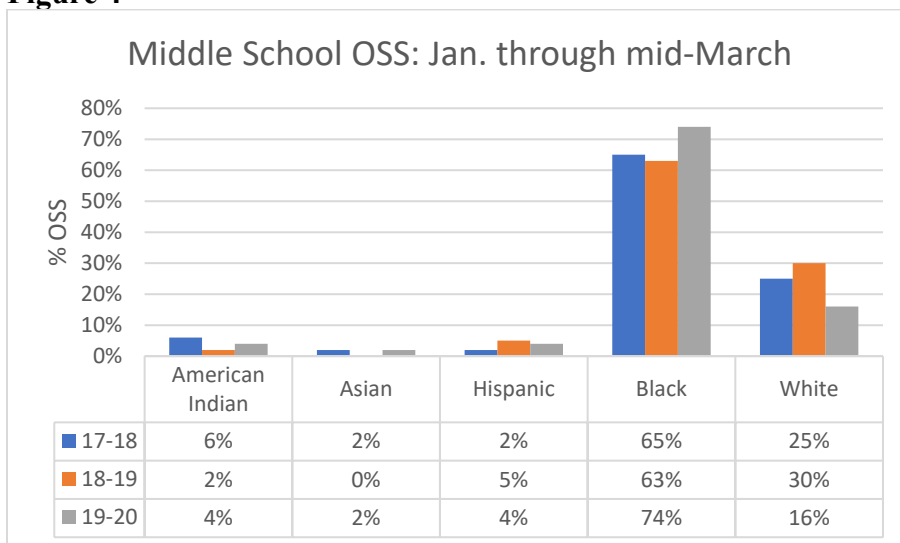
