<u>Summer Riverboat Trips</u>

Interested in accompanying your loved one on a refreshing riverboat trip this summer? If so, please contact his or her Recreation Therapist (RT). Each RT is listed below, along with the schedule of riverboat trips organized by building number, floor, and date. The sooner you call, the better, as there is limited space available. The Family Council donates to this delightful summer activity. One family member may accompany each resident at no charge. Additional family members are welcome, but please pay for those tickets separately at the boat, which ensures that as many residents/ Veterans as possible have an opportunity to attend. Please let your loved one's RT know if additional family members plan to attend so that can be communicated to the Padelford Boat Company.

As noted below, the riverboat leaves the dock at 12:00 Noon for all but two of the trips. It leaves at 2:30pm for Building 19-2, which is scheduled on August 14th, and at 2:30pm for Building 21-2, which is scheduled on August 12th. The residents and sponsored family members should be at the MVH-Minneapolis Main Entrance two hours in advance of the boat departure time, where the buses will be loaded. Or meet them at Harriet Island an hour in advance instead. The trips that are scheduled for a Noon departure will include lunch provided at no charge on the boat. Those departing at 2:30pm will have lunch at the Vets Home at their usual time. The buses will return to the MVH-Minneapolis three to four hours afterwards. Residents and families are welcome to purchase anything extra on the boat. Friendly reminder: Alcohol is not permitted on any Recreation Therapy (state) outings. Watch for flyers posted around campus for more details.
