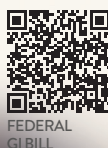
**CONNECTING VETERANS AND THEIR FAMILIES

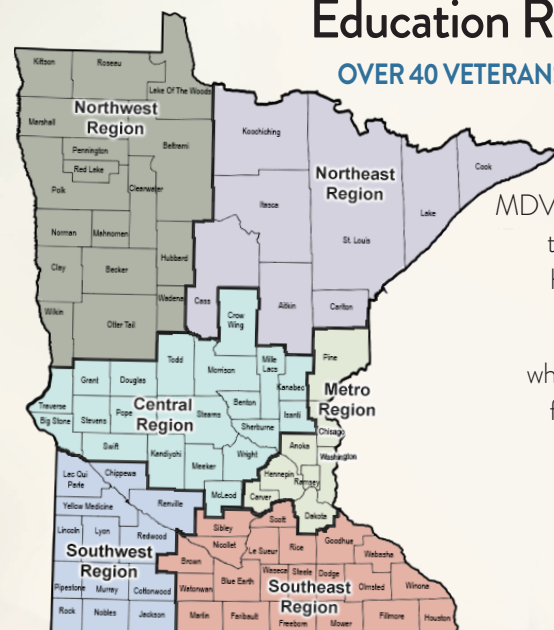
