WELCOME HOME

Minnesota Veterans Homes - Preston is located in Fillmore County, part of southeast Minnesota's historic bluff country. A Veteran-friendly community in the Root River Valley, Preston is also home to one of four State Veterans Cemeteries, several active military service posts and The Club, which hosts events celebrating all branches of the armed forces.

This 54-Resident skilled nursing facility is built on a 15-acre blufftop site surrounded by a 200-year-old native white oak forest. In addition to private rooms and baths and panoramic views of the area, the Home also offers well-appointed, fenced-in courtyards and gardens, a Town Center featuring a coffee shop/café, theatre/meeting room, dining room, meditation room/chapel, club room for entertaining family and friends and three 18-Resident "households" to create a small-community feeling.

With a dedication to developing person-centered care plans that best meet individual clinical needs and personal preferences, the Home's team appreciates a strong volunteer network and is highly engaged in local events.

After more than a decade of advocacy and planning, the Preston Veterans Home opened in early 2024. The staff is committed to providing a trusted, dignified environment of caring for Veterans and their families with passion, integrity and teamwork every day.



Admission Requirements



All Residents must require skilled nursing care. Eligible Residents include:

- Veterans discharged under honorable conditions from any branch of the U.S. armed forces and a current resident of Minnesota, who served 181 consecutive days on active duty, unless discharged earlier because of disability incurred in the line of duty.
- Spouses of eligible Veterans, who must be at least 55 years old and meet residency requirements.
- Veterans or Veteran spouses must meet definitions as included in Minn. Stat. 197.447.
