



FLORAL POLICIES

- Fresh cut flowers may be placed on graves at any time of the year. Only temporary flower containers are permitted.
- Permanent plantings will not be permitted on graves at any time.
- Artificial flowers and potted plants may be placed on graves during the periods from October 15th through April 15th, and for a period extending 10 days before through 10 days after Easter Sunday and Memorial Day.
- Floral items will be removed from graves when they become faded or unsightly, or when it becomes necessary to facilitate cemetery operations.
- Christmas wreaths, grave blankets and other seasonal adornments are permitted on graves from November 1st through February 1st.
- Statues, vigil lights, glass or breakable objects of any nature, and other types of commemorative items are not permitted on graves at any time.
- Floral items and other types of decorations must not be secured to headstones or markers.
- Small American Flags are not considered to be floral items and will be removed from graves, except for a period extending 10 days before through 10 days after Memorial Day.
- The Minnesota State Veterans Cemetery is not responsible for maintaining, replacing or safeguarding floral items placed on graves.
- Any unauthorized items found on graves will be removed and disposed of by cemetery personnel.
