

Minneapolis Veterans Home Construction Phases

Phase 1

Completed in 2012, phase one included a skilled nursing care facility that incorporating the latest technology and modern amenities to enhance care. This building has 100 private rooms designed around “neighborhoods” to offer care in a home-style atmosphere. This facility includes a greenhouse, barber and beauty shops, common areas and a town square with natural light and greenery.

Budget: \$29 million. Breakdown: \$19 million in Federal VA funding and a \$10 million match from the State of Minnesota.

Phase 2 – Complete

Phase two was completed in 2016 and features 100 private rooms with their own bathrooms, a commercial kitchen, exercise rooms and therapy space – all focused on the philosophy of Resident-centered care.

Budget: \$33.5 million. Breakdown: \$21.25 million Federal VA funding and a \$12.25 million match from the State of Minnesota.

Phase 3 – Complete

The third and final phase of the construction project at the Minneapolis Veterans Home Campus includes a 100-bed skilled care facility and infrastructure that ties the existing and future complex together with a service tunnel. Like the other two phases, the phase three facility will also be a “neighborhood” design and focus on Resident-centered care. Phase three was completed in March 2018.

Budget: \$54.1 million. Breakdown: \$35 million federal in Federal VA funding and a \$18.9 million match from the State of Minnesota.
