SUBJECT:	April Revenue Review	

Net general fund revenues totaled \$3.815 billion for the month of April, \$391 million (11.4 percent) more than forecast. Net receipts from individual income tax for the month were higher than forecast while net sales tax, corporate franchise tax, and other revenues were less than forecast. For fiscal year 2025, year-to-date receipts are now \$26.370 billion, \$635 million (2.5 percent) more than forecast.

All results are preliminary and subject to revision. Monthly revenue variances (differences between forecasted and actual values) should be interpreted with great caution. Large variances are often caused by variations in the rate at which receipts are received and processed and differences in the rate at which refunds are issued. Other revenues often include unallocated accounts receivable which will be added to receipts for the appropriate tax when identified. A more complete report covering April, May, and June 2025 receipts will be issued as part of Minnesota Management and Budget's July 2025 *Revenue and Economic Update*.
