- Build a support network of people working through similar problems


## Federal Developments

- The U.S. DOT issued a <u>memo</u> to state DOTs that threatened to withhold federal funding if state DOTs do not adhere to the administration's DEI guidance or cooperate with immigration authorities
- A <u>court</u> found an executive order that directed withholding funds from sanctuary cities unconstitutional
- Auto tariffs reduced
- NSF joins NIH and DOE in reducing <u>indirect costs to 15%</u>. Suit filed by a collection of universities.
- The President released a budget proposal with \$163B in proposed cuts
- Reconciliation hearings are happening (2025 bill)—future of direct pay being discussed

- \$3.4 billion in institutional giving (\$5.25 in individual giving!)
- 52.6% stays in Minnesota (83% Twin Cities metro; 17%
   Greater Minnesota)
- Human services, education, & health are largest giving areas

# Supplemental Info

#### Al screening for words and themes

- Analysis has shown that words associated with themes in issued executive orders and federal agency guidance are being removed or replaced on federal websites.
- Federal agencies may be conducting AI screening for these or similar words in federal grant applications and reporting.
- Applications and reports that omit these words or themes may not trigger additional review.

#### A Note on Recent Guidance

**Example Guidance: Department of Labor**. "Starting on March 17, 2025, grant recipients are required to submit a justification with each payment request submitted to PMS."

## Reminders/Best Practices

- Grants with signed agreements appear to be somewhat stable for the time being
- Some grants may be terminated for convenience—check terms and conditions
  - The standard terms and conditions are being amended by EPA to make grants easier to cancel for convenience
  - Stay consistent with terms and conditions
- Get any directives in writing
- Know that calls may be recorded
  - Folks from the federal government and potentially DOGE in particular are joining meetings.
- Reporting and funding applications: anticipate use of AI screening for key words.
- Court cases continue: Covid and FEMA fund cancellations were blocked; reductions in force blocked, then unblocked.
