Our Focus Areas

- 1. Monitor the federal landscape
- 2. Advance the resourcing of strategically significant projects

Purpose of this call

While we can't provide clarity right now, we can:

- Share information to facilitate risk analyses
 - Tracking federal funding blockages and cancellations
 - Tracking federal guidance and executive orders
 - Tracking other contextual events in the federal landscape
- Provide a space for others to share information and strategies
- Build a support network of people working through similar problems

Federal Funding Developments

- Twenty States and the District of Columbia File Lawsuit Against Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) to Prevent Changes to Continuum of Care (CoC) Program The FY 2025 Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) for the CoC set an application deadline of January 14, 2026. The NOFO changes the funding structure of CoC and sets a cap on awards for permanent supportive housing projects.
- <u>Federal Transit Administration (FTA) Removes Immigration Enforcement Requirement from Master</u>

 <u>Agreement for Grants</u> The change is in response to a recent court ruling finding the requirement unlawful.
- The USDOT <u>sent a proposal to OMB</u> to significantly pare back direct transit funding and reallocate that funding to highways, and also to eliminate states' ability to flex highway dollars for transit.
- Metro Transit, MnDOT, and smaller transit agencies received a combined <u>total of \$82M+</u> in federal funding for <u>no/low emission transit buses</u>.
- The administration has threatened to withhold <u>SNAP management funds</u> from states that refuse to share SNAP recipient personal data to the federal government. Minnesota is one of those states.

Funding-Adjacent Developments

- Cases against former <u>FBI director Comey and NY State AG James</u> were thrown out because a court determined that U.S. Attorney Lindsey Halligan was illegally appointed.
- An appeals court affirmed the <u>disqualification of U.S. Attorney Alina Habba</u>, concluding that she was illegally appointed.
- DOGE has been officially dismantled.
- The CFPB will issues a mass furlough by year-end.
- The Administration is rolling back fuel efficiency standards (<u>CAFE standards</u>)
 for cars and trucks

Al screening for words and themes

- Analysis has shown that words associated with themes in issued executive orders and federal agency guidance are being removed or replaced on federal websites.
- Federal agencies may be conducting Al screening for these or similar words in federal grant applications and reporting.
- Applications and reports that omit these words or themes may not trigger additional review.

Reminders/Best Practices

- Grants with signed agreements appear to be somewhat stable for the time being
- Some grants may be terminated for convenience—check terms and conditions
 - The standard terms and conditions are being amended by EPA to make grants easier to cancel for convenience
 - Stay consistent with terms and conditions
- Get any directives in writing
- Know that calls may be recorded
 - Folks from the federal government and potentially DOGE in particular are joining meetings.
- Reporting and funding applications: anticipate use of AI screening for key words.
