This transfer positions Minnesota to rapidly deploy funds in support projects that can 1.) leverage loans available through the U.S. Department of Energy under the Inflation Reduction Act; and/or 2) claim federal tax credits for investments in clean energy. MnCIFA will use the transfer to provide additional bridge (i.e., upfront) loans to entities with projects that are eligible for tax credits and can use the tax credits to repay loans upon project completion.
