RE: Encourage Agency Employees to Receive W-2 Electronically

A message has been posted on the <u>Self Service Announcements page</u> reminding employees of the advantages of receiving their W-2 electronically. Agencies should encourage their employees to consent to receive their W-2 online to facilitate saving time on reprint requests and keeping personal information confidential.

- FIHU2457 report: this report identifies any employees who are currently receiving paper W-2s. Designated agency staff should run the report and encourage employees to consent to receive their W-2 online.

FIHU2457, Employees with No W-2 Consent

This On-Demand report will identify employees who are in an active or paid leave status on the Primary Job and:

- Have not consented to receive their W-2 online.
- Waived their consent.
- Not answered W-2 consent question.

Designated agency staff should run this report and encourage those employees to log into employee self-service and consent to receive W-2s online.
