

IRRRB FACILITIES RESOURCE WORKER

KIND OF WORK

Seasonal service work which includes operation of machinery.

NATURE AND PURPOSE

Under general supervision, performs a variety of semi-skilled trades, maintenance and operation services work so that IRRRB facilities operate smoothly; performs related work as required. Work assignments are distinct by season; incumbents perform duties in one or a combination of the IRRRB facilities (Ironworld, Giants Ridge, Mineland Reclamation, etc.)

EXAMPLES OF WORK (A position may not include all the work examples given, nor does the list include all that may be assigned.)

Operates snow making and grooming equipment so that ski slopes are in good condition using snow making guns and track snow grooming dozers and attachments.

Operates chair lifts at Giants Ridge ski area so that the skiing public is safe by monitoring lift access and operation, enforcing safety rules, inspecting the lift, and communicating problems to the the General Repair Worker.

Repairs and adjusts equipment and maintains facilities of IRRRB in preparation for an upcoming season by servicing grooming equipment, snowmaking equipment and lifts, fixing minor mechanical and electrical problems, cutting brush, removing debris, and refurbishing buildings.

Cuts brush and trees so that IRRRB facilities are maintained and other projects can be accomplished by using bulldozers, a one ton dump truck, brushing equipment, chainsaws, and other equipment.

Transplants trees so that mineland reclamation and community projects can be completed by operating a Vermeer tree mover and related equipment.

Plants and fertilizes seedling trees and grass so that erosion of IRRRB facilities and land projects can be controlled by using bulldozers, dump trucks, and other equipment.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

Knowledge of:

IRRRB programs sufficient to be able to perform duties at various locations.

The methods, materials, and tools used in carpentry, electrical, and mechanical work sufficient to make minor equipment repairs and adjustments.

Snowgrooming procedures, lifts, and snowmaking equipment and processes sufficient to insure that the ski slopes are in good condition.

Tree and grass planting and fertilizing procedures sufficient to ensure successful completion of mineland reclamation community projects.

Ability to:

Operate motorized equipment such as tractors, backhoes, forklifts, snow guns, snow groomers, tree moving equipment (Vermeer), and chainsaws.

Work in the field with limited supervision.

Lift heavy objects such as attachments for snow grooming equipment, fencing, small trees, lumber, audio visual equipment, chainsaws, etc.

SPECIAL WORKING CONDITIONS

Work is primarily outside, sometimes in extreme weather conditions (summer and winter). Lights and chairlift maintenance require working 30 feet from the ground.
