

TRANSPORTATION ASSOCIATE

KIND OF WORK

Entry level para-engineering and/or maintenance work.

NATURE AND PURPOSE

Employees perform daily and routine work assignments following established procedures. Work may involve the use of specialized road maintenance and road construction equipment and technology.

EXAMPLES OF WORK (A position may not include all the work examples given, nor does the list include all that may be assigned.)

- Install and repair temporary signs.
- Maintain roadway surfaces and shoulders.
- Set up and remove snow fences and permanent traffic barriers.
- Direct and control traffic around maintenance and construction projects.
- Operate and transport road maintenance equipment, materials and supplies.
- Remove snow and ice from roadways.
- Perform minor repairs and preventative maintenance on equipment, bridges and buildings using basic carpentry skills.
- Maintain field and laboratory testing equipment and prepare laboratory samples.
- Conduct routine testing and inspection of road construction and maintenance materials.
- Serve on survey crew.
- Dispose of hazardous waste materials.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES REQUIRED

Knowledge of:

- Processes/equipment/materials used in maintaining roadway surfaces and shoulders.
- Processes/equipment/materials used in snow and ice removal.
- Processes for collecting laboratory samples of road and soil materials.
- Hazardous waste disposal.

Ability to:

- Operate heavy equipment used in road maintenance and snow and ice removal.

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License:

- Some positions require a Commercial Driver License (CDL) at the time of hire or within six months after being hired.
