



 - Legislators, Partisan and Non-Partisan Staff, DHS and DOC Executives, County Administrators, County Commissioners, County Coordinator













Timeline



Programs Available for Benefit-Cost Analysis

- Criteria for inclusion
 1. Included in WSIPP's statistical model
 2. Program design in Minnesota matches those in rigorous evaluations
 3. Statewide estimates for cost per participant available
- Some programs may be added or subtracted from the list
