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



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
# Benefit Cost Ratio

\*Uses statewide costs and model<sup>4</sup>

1. The DOC & illustrative counties each compile program inventories.
2. Population (recidivism & usage) data *may* be a statewide average or geography specific.
3. Resource use will reflect statewide average costs. This phase will assume statewide average costs are similar to costs incurred by example counties.
4. County ROTI results will be representative of programs run by other counties, if example counties offer similar recidivism programs.
