Presented on Thursday, Nov. 1, at the Minneapolis Convention Center, the Tekne Awards honor those who play a significant role in discovering new technologies that educate, improve lifestyles, and impact the lives and futures of people living in Minnesota and all over the world. Categories and finalists for the 2012 Tekne Awards are:

ADVANCED MANUFACTURING AWARD

The Advanced Manufacturing Award honors technological advancement in the manufacturing of materials or chemicals, machinery and equipment, electronics and components, measuring instruments, photonics, optics and lasers. Finalists are: **3M** (Saint Paul), **Seagate Technology** (Bloomington) and **Top Tool Co.** (Blaine).

CLEANTECH & ENERGY AWARD

The Cleantech & Energy Award recognizes organizations that develop environmentally-sound products or solutions that reduce costs, energy consumption, waste or pollution. Examples include but are not limited to: solar or wind power, biofuels, green building supplies, personal transportation or smart grid. Finalists are: **Biovation Holdings Inc.** (Mankato), **SheerWind, Inc.** (Chaska) and **TransUNImission, Inc.** (Burnsville).

COMPUTER HARDWARE & ELECTRONIC DEVICES AWARD

The Computer Hardware & Electronic Devices Award honors innovative development of computer products, equipment or consumer electronic devices. Examples include but are not limited to server and storage devices, mainframes, PCs and memory cards. Finalists are: **Imation Corp.–DataGuard** (Oakdale), **Imation Corp.–RDX Media Secure** (Oakdale) and **Network Instruments, LLC** (Minnetonka).

EDTECH AWARD

The EdTech Award recognizes the development of technologies and innovations that enhance teaching and learning both in and out of the classroom. Finalists are: **eLumen Collaborative** (Minneapolis), **St. Cloud State University** (St. Cloud) and the **University of Minnesota Rochester** (Rochester).

INNOVATIVE COLLABORATION OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Innovative Collaboration of the Year Award honors any type of collaboration or partnership that demonstrates leadership, dedication and excellence in delivering an innovation to Minnesota. There must be two or more parties involved with the collaboration. The finalists are: **Blandin Foundation** (Grand Rapids), **Digineer** (Plymouth) and **page10** (Minneapolis).

LIFE SCIENCES AWARD

The Life Sciences Award recognizes innovative development of medical devices, diagnostics or equipment, disease treatment, pharmaceuticals, agriculture or food science. Established company finalists are: **3M** (Saint Paul), **Starkey Hearing Technologies** (Eden Prairie) and **Vital Images, Inc.** (Minnetonka). Small-and-growing company finalists are: **Cardio3 BioSciences** (Rochester), **Circle Biologics, Inc.** (Plymouth) and **OrthoCor Medical** (Minneapolis).

MOBILE & COMMUNICATION TECHNOLOGIES AWARD

The Mobile & Communications Technologies Award honors innovation in mobile applications and electronic communication, including but not limited to social media, internet broadcasting, digital data integration, streaming audio/video and highly interactive user interfaces. Finalists are: **MakeMusic, Inc.** (Eden Prairie), the **Minnesota Governor's Council on Developmental Disabilities** (Saint Paul) and **Starkey Hearing Technologies** (Eden Prairie).

ROBOTICS & AUTOMATION AWARD

The Robotics & Automation Award recognizes notable achievements in robotics and automation. Finalists are: **PaR Systems, Inc.** (Shoreview), **ReconRobotics, Inc.** (Edina) and **Robotics Innovation LLC** (Minneapolis).

SOFTWARE AWARD

The Software Award honors companies who show innovative development of applications for business or consumer use. The Startup Award recognizes an early-stage Minnesota technology company with commercialized products that demonstrates significant potential, creativity and a promising future. The company must be less than three years old, have 1-30 employees and generate revenue. The finalists are: **Sophia Learning, LLC** (Minneapolis) and **SparkWeave, LLC** (Minneapolis).

TECHNOLOGY EXCELLENCE IN A NON-PROFIT ORGANIZATION AWARD

The Technology Excellence in A Non-Profit Organization Award honors a non-profit organization whose innovative use of technology has allowed or will allow the organization to more effectively deliver on its mission and serve the state of Minnesota and its communities. Finalists are: **GiveMN** (Saint Paul), **MacPhail Center for Music** (Minneapolis) and **The Works** (Bloomington).

TECHNOLOGY SERVICES & CONSULTING AWARD

The Technology Services Award recognizes providers of computer and internet-related services to businesses and consumers, including but not limited to software consulting, disaster recovery, Web design, data input and processing, security, e-commerce services, business services and Web hosting.
