Session 3 – County's Role in Developmental Disabilities

Competencies

- 1. Participants will be able to demonstrate knowledge of the service coordination (case management) system and what services are available.
- 2. Participants will understand the principles of choice and control, and their application to self-directed and/or person-centered planning for people with developmental disabilities and families.
- 3. Participants will understand that a flexible, responsive system of supports for the families of children with disabilities is the cornerstone for a true system of community supports for people with developmental disabilities and families.
- 4. Participants will create a shared vision for the year 2030 and beyond.
- 5. Participants will learn how to meet a public official and discuss issues.

Homework

- Complete your Portfolio of Public Officials. You do not need to complete the "Schools" section on the last page. Bring your completed Portfolio to the January weekend as you might be using this in class. You do not need to turn it in.
- 2. Contact one of your County Commissioners (by phone, mail, or email), or call to schedule an appointment to discuss a developmental disabilities issue. Prepare a brief summary (2-3 paragraphs) about your phone conversation or meeting OR make a copy of your letter or email. Either email the summary/copy or bring to the January weekend session.
- 3. Send thank you letters or emails to at least two speakers/presenters for this weekend session. Email the names or bring a list of the speakers/presenters to whom you sent a thank you to the January session.
- 4. If you have reliable internet access, go to Partners in Policymaking website to download the app "Telling Your Story." Complete the steps to prepare yourself for your upcoming contacts with county commissioners and state legislators in March.
