PREVALENCE OF FEEBLE-MINDED IN PENAL and CORRECTIONAL INSTITUTIONS

The following data are taken from the last three biennial reports. It gives the percentages of the new admissions during the biennium whose intelligence quotients fall below .75 on individual examination, except for the Prison in 1926. The 42 percent here is of the total Prison population in January, 1926. Inasmuch as all are delinquents below an I.Q. of .75, they would all presumably legally classify as feeble-minded.
