

MONTHLY REPORT
May - 1960

FARM

The garden crew planted carrots, cabbage, beans, and 1,400 tomato plants. Some weeding was done. Asparagus and rhubarb were cut.

Hog house herdsman reports 98 pigs born, 3.1 brood sows vaccinated for erysipelas, and 120 pigs vaccinated for cholera and erysipelas. One hundred twenty pigs were moved into the new hog barn.

General farm crew hauled 600 bales and 500 bushels of corn to dairy and finished planting 136 acres of oats. About 190 acres of corn were planted; 88 acres of corn are left to plant due to wet soil conditions. Some of the early corn will have to be replanted due to wet ground and quack grass.

The farm roads were graded; about 55 yards of gravel were hauled around new hog barn.
