Mrs. Myers probably has the most well organized treatment approach of any of our Unit Directors. The guts of her report is exhibit (A) with which you should become familiar.

The rest of the material is supplemental to her earlier program material description. The biggest problems I see now in Skinner are:

- 1) Lack of programs or structured instruction for Holly residents.
- 2) No pre-vocational programs.
- 3) Lack of continuity between rehabilitation programs and nursing (Some of the Rehab. programs would appear to be designed for normal adult people-like Rehab. staff).
- 4) Lack of a sequential program for other residents. After you learn to brush your teeth-what comes next?
- 5) I also raise the question about community placements but Winnie has most of her people referred.

As a result of a discussion we had we established the following goals for Skinner in the next three months. (See copy). Winnie is doing a good job and would like for you to tell her.
