



## Steps for Finding Create Account & Apply

This guide is to help you locate the “Create Account & Apply” button on MNSure’s refreshed website. Beginning November 15, the mnsure.org homepage will prominently feature orange “New Coverage” and “Renew Coverage” buttons that will link directly to the respective pages in the Individuals & Families section.

### Steps to follow until November 15:

Go to [www.mnsure.org](http://www.mnsure.org) and this is the first page you will see. Click on Financial Assistance under Quick Links.
