Minutes from July 19, 2021 Minnesota Racing Commission Meeting

MINUTES

Call to Order:

Agenda Item 1 - Chair McArdle called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m. CDT

Roll Call:

Agenda Item 2 – Present – Chair McArdle, First Vice Chair Colombo, Second Vice Chair Colombo, Commissioners Dehn, Erhart, Goodman, Johnson, and McArdle. A quorum was acknowledged.

Other participants – E. Joseph Newton (General Counsel, Minnesota Racing Commission), Andrew Offerman (Vice President of Racing Operations, Canterbury Park), Taro Ito (President/CEO, Running Aces Casino, Hotel, and Racetrack), Steve Carpenito (Director of Racing, Running Aces Casino, Hotel, and Racetrack), Lynn Hovda, DVM (Chief Commission Veterinarian, Minnesota Racing Commission), Randy Blaseg (Chief State Steward, Minnesota Racing Commission), Robert Corey (Presiding Judge, Minnesota Racing Commission), Bob Schiewe (Deputy Executive Director, Minnesota Racing Commission), Cathy Dessert (Vice President, Minnesota Harness Racing, Inc.), Mike Cronin (Executive Director, Minnesota Horsemen's Benevolent and Protective Association)

Adoption of Agenda:

Agenda Item 3 – Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the Second by Commissioner Erhart. Motion carried.

Approval of Minutes:

Agenda Item 4 - Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 21, 2021 Commission Meeting. Second by Commissioner Dehn. Motion carried.

Old Business:

Agenda Item 5 – Chair McArdle referenced the letter from Taro Ito, President and CEO of Running Aces Casino, Hotel, and Racetrack (“Running Aces”) to withdraw Item 5 from the agenda. Commissioner Johnson made a motion to accept the request from Running Aces to accept the request to withdraw the item. Second by Commissioner Dehn. Motion carried with unanimous consent.

Action Items:

Agenda Item 6 – Approval of Track Superintendent for Canterbury Park - Executive Director May introduced the item, explaining the Minnesota rule for approving an emergency racing official and the letters that the Commission received from Canterbury Park. Commissioner Johnson made a motion to approve George Moncreif as the Track Superintendent for Canterbury Park for the remainder of the 2021 live racing season. Second by Commissioner Erhart. Motion carried with unanimous consent.

Agenda Item 7 - Authorizing Resolution to Proceed with Rulemaking and Publish Request for Comments – General Counsel Newton explained the rulemaking process and the order he had drafted for Chair McArdle. If approved the Commission would publish a request for comments to begin the rulemaking process. Chair McArdle read the resolution to authorize the initiation of the rulemaking process (attached). Motion to approve the resolution was made by Commissioner Johnson. Second by

Commissioner Dehn. General Counsel Newton clarified that this was a regular rulemaking process and briefly outlined the process. Executive Director May explained that the process was starting now to ensure that rule changes would be finalized prior to the 2022 live racing season. Motion carried with unanimous consent.

Informational Items

Agenda Item 8a – Status Report, Canterbury Park – Mr. Offerman expressed his appreciation of the approval of Mr. Moncrief and briefly described the actions taken by Canterbury Park related to the sudden death of Mr. Ramiro Flores. Mr. Offerman briefed the Commission on the ongoing race meet and their satisfaction with wagering handle. Mr. Offerman briefly outlined the break planned for the Twin Cities Summer Jam. Mr. Offerman updated the Commission on the parking upgrades at Canterbury Park and explained their satisfaction with the cardroom operations. Commissioner Goodman voiced her satisfaction with Canterbury Park for the Ralph Strangis Stakes events. Mr. Offerman provided an update on the Canterbury Park 2021 Hall of Fame Class (<https://www.canterburypark.com/blog/canterbury-park-hall-of-fame-class-of-2021-announced/>)

Agenda Item 8b – Status Report, Running Aces – Mr. Carpenito briefed the Commission on the ongoing race meet and their satisfaction with the wagering handle even with a decreased number of horses racing. Mr. Ito explained his satisfaction with the amended racing schedule in 2021 and high occupancy rates in the hotel.

Agenda Item 9a(i) – Chief Veterinarian’s Report, Canterbury Park – Dr. Hovda explained that the number of medication violations at Canterbury Park is lower in 2021 than previous years and that the number of horses required an official workout in front of the veterinarians has increased but that new procedures have assisted in this. Dr. Hovda explained that the official laboratory has been slower with results but within contractual obligations. Dr. Hovda described hair testing for the American Quarter Horse Association Challenge races.

Agenda Item 9a(ii) – Chief Veterinarian’s Report, Running Aces – Dr. Hovda explained that the number of medication violations at Running Aces is lower in 2021 than previous years. Dr. Hovda described the increased number of claims at both racetracks in 2021. Dr. Hovda explained the changes to Minnesota racing rules that went into effect in July 2021.

Agenda Item 9b – Chief State Steward’s Report – Mr. Blaseg described the increased number of claims at Canterbury Park in 2021 and his satisfaction with Quarter Horse racing in 2021.

Agenda Item 9c – Presiding Judge’s Report – Mr. Corey expressed his satisfaction with live racing at Running Aces in 2021, especially with the United States Trotting Association internship program. Executive Director May expressed his satisfaction as well with the internship and his appreciation with the judges in working with the intern, which was echoed by Commissioner Johnson.

Agenda Item 10 – Deputy Director’s Report – Deputy Director Schiewe voiced his appreciation for both racetracks in adding 2019 comparison data to their monthly reports as requested by the Commission. Mr. Schiewe explained that June Advanced Deposit Wagering handle was down in June 2021 vs May 2021 and June 2020 but that Fiscal Year 2021 Advanced Deposit Wagering handle exceeded projections by 25%. Mr. Schiewe described total Advanced Deposit Wagering fees collected by the Commission and that additional detail would be provided in the August 2021 Commission meeting materials. Mr. Offerman asked to work with Commission staff on reporting Advanced Deposit Wagering fees and the overall impact of Advanced Deposit Wagering handle after the COVID-19 pandemic, which was encouraged by Chair McArdle.

Agenda Item 11 – Executive Director’s Report – Executive Director provided a brief update on COVID-19 and explained that things are progressing well. Director May described the need for more in-person

meetings since the emergency executive orders from Governor Walz have expired and there are statutory needs to have in-person meetings going forward. Director May referred the Commission members to the licensing report and explained that the fines collected in Fiscal Year 2021 were correct and his appreciate for Commission team members for helping out to cover licensing hours. Director May gave an update on the 2020 federal legislation for the implementation of the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Agency, explaining that there is a great deal of details that need to be finalized. Director May gave an update on the 2020 rulemaking implementation and the plans for 2021 rulemaking.

Agenda Item 12 – Industry Updates

Minnesota Harness Racing, Inc. – Ms. Dessert provided a report on the Ron Banks Memorial Trot and a visit from Agricultural Commissioner Thom Peterson. Ms. Dessert provided a report on successful 2yo racing at Running Aces. Ms. Dessert voiced the concern about harness racing inclusion in the Horseracing Integrity and Safety Agency.

Minnesota Horsemen’s Benevolent and Protective Association – Mr. Cronin expressed his satisfaction with the first half of the racing season at Canterbury Park. Mr. Cronin explained that a horsewoman was recently injured but was quickly assisted by fellow horsepeople. Mr. Cronin gave a brief update on the Abijah’s on the Backside program, stating that he would be getting an update from the individuals involved on the program. Director May voiced his appreciation for outreach programs for backside workers that are initiated by the HBPA. Chair McArdle echoed this, especially the dental program and other health initiatives.

Announce Future Meetings: The next Full Commission Meeting will take place Monday, August 16, 2021, 4:00 p.m. CDT at a location that is to be determined. Chair McArdle expressed her pleasure with the Creekside Community Center location and her desire to secure the same location for future meetings.

Adjournment: Chair McArdle adjourned the meeting at 5:08 p.m. CDT

Election of Minnesota Racing Commission First and Second Vice Chair

BYLAWS OF THE MINNESOTA RACING COMMISSION

SECTION 1. NAME

The Minnesota Racing Commission (hereinafter the "Commission") is composed of nine members, including a Chair.

SECTION 2. OFFICERS OF THE COMMISSION

2.1 Chair

The Chair shall preside at all meetings of the Commission and shall have such duties and responsibilities as are normally attendant upon that office and as are specifically prescribed by Minn. Stat. ch. 240, other relevant laws, and these bylaws. The functions of the Chair shall include, but not be limited to:

- (a) Presiding at meetings of the Commission;
- (b) Providing notification of regular meetings of the Commission and calling special Commission meetings as appropriate;
- (c) Appointing, subject to Commission approval, any special committees and related chairs;
- (d) Assuring that the work of the Commission is organized to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the Commission;
- (e) Representing the Commission and acting as its official spokesman where appropriate;
- (f) Performing such other duties as the Commission may direct.

2.2 Vice-Chair

The Vice-Chair shall be elected from the Commission's membership at the first regular meeting in August of each year by a majority vote of the Commission members. The Vice-Chair shall act as Chair in the absence of the Chair.

A vacancy in the office of Vice-Chair shall be filled for the duration of the applicable term by majority vote of the Commission members at any regular meeting of the Commission following development of such a vacancy.

2.3 Second Vice-Chair

The second Vice-Chair shall be elected from the Commission's membership at the first regular meeting in August of each year by a majority vote of the Commission members. The second Vice-Chair shall act as the Chair in the absence of the Chair and the Vice-Chair.

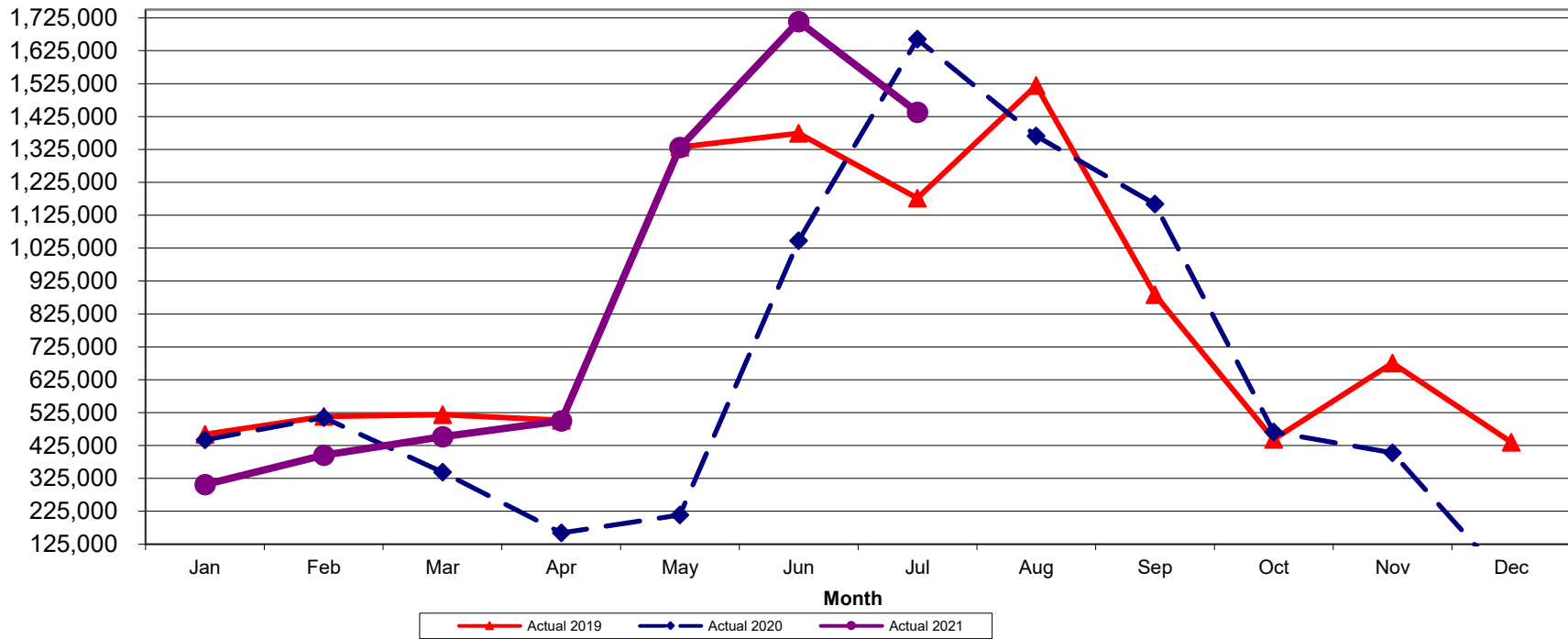

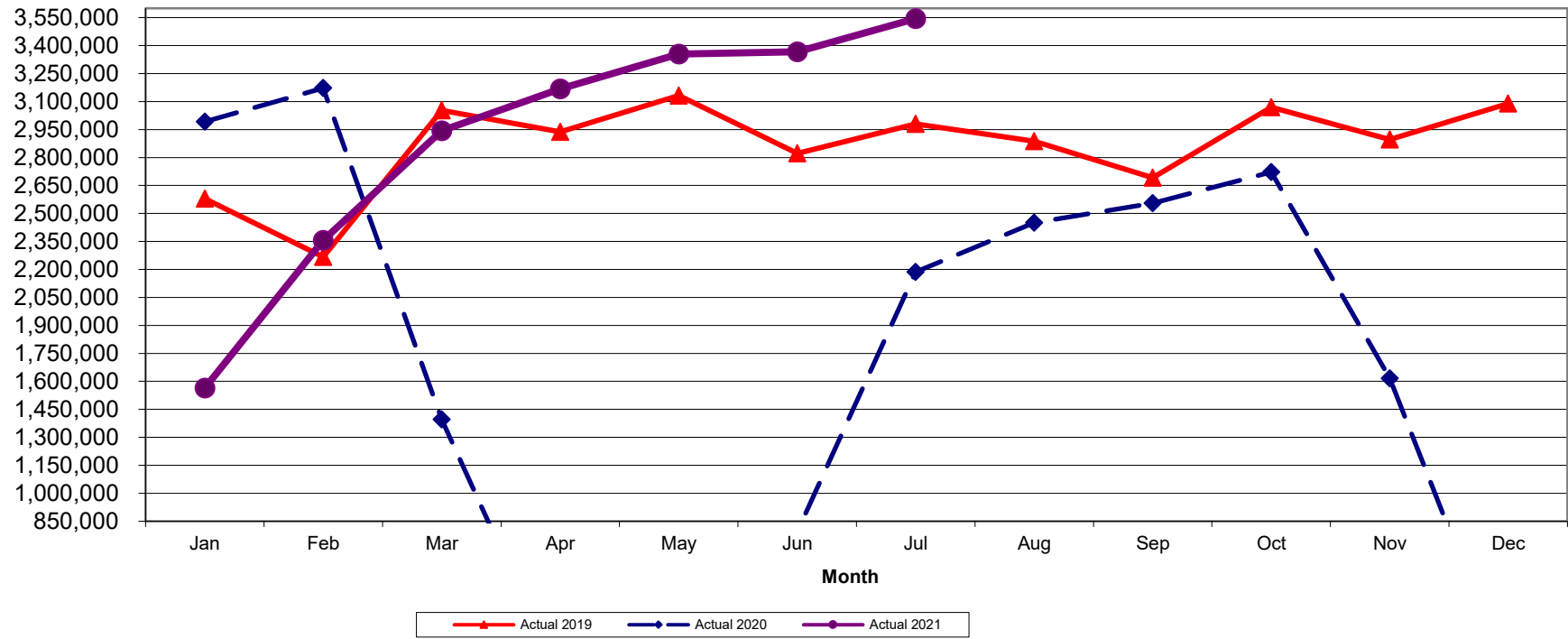
PARI - MUTUEL REVENUES

Presiding Judge's Report

Judges Report for July 2021 at Running Aces

As we pass the halfway mark in the 2021 Running Aces harness racing meet, the judges are pleased to report that racing continues to be decent, and the trainers and drivers are following the rules and regulations quite well.

The number of entries in the box has improved as the meet progresses. The addition of the 2-year old's racing has helped immensely. A couple of small stables arriving from Michigan has also been a benefit.

Eleven rulings were issued during the month of July, bringing the season total to 29. Six of those rulings were for misuse of the whip. The drivers are still adjusting to the more stringent whipping rules implemented for the 2021 racing season. Otherwise driving infractions have been minimal.

Tuesday July 27th saw a season high \$235,166 wagered on a 9-race program. There was a mandatory pick five payout that generated quite a bit of interest. The on-track crowds have been good and enthusiastic. The racing program on Thursday July 29th was cancelled due to poor air quality in the region. We have also had to move post time back an hour on two separate occasions because of high heat index concerns. Those programs were completed without any issues.
