Call to Order:

**Agenda Item 1 – Call to Order**

Chair McArdle called the meeting to order at 4:02 p.m.

Roll Call:

**Agenda Item 2 – Roll Call**

Present – Chair McArdle, Vice Chair Colombo, Second Vice Chair Johnson, Commissioners Dehn, Erhart, Idelkope and Gingold. A quorum was acknowledged.

Joseph Newton (General Counsel, Minnesota Racing Commission), Randy Sampson (President/CEO, Canterbury Park and Entertainment), Andrew Offerman (Vice President Canterbury Park and Entertainment), Steve Carpenito (Director of Racing, Running Aces Casino, Hotel, and Racetrack), Taro Ito (President/CEO, Running Aces Casino, Hotel, and Racetrack), Aaron Bedessem (Vice President Running Aces Casino) Mike Cronin (Minnesota Horsemen’s Benevolent and Protective Association), Lynn Hovda DVM(Chief Veterinarian Minnesota Racing Commission), Robert Corey (Chief Judge Minnesota Racing Commission).

**Agenda Item 3 – Approval of Agenda**

Commissioner Dehn motioned to approve the agenda; Second by Commissioner Erhart; Motion carried.

**Agenda Item 4 – Approval of Minutes**

Motion to approve the minutes by Johnson; Second by Colombo. Motion passed.

**Agenda Item 5 – Committee Reports**

**A. Aftercare Committee**

Commissioner Colombo presented this item. She spoke about the updated draft of the aftercare grant applications and the grant making process. There was a brief overview of potential grant financial information. Chair McArdle added comments.

**B. Racing Committee**

Commissioner Colombo introduced this item. She spoke about the presentation that had occurred and the Racing Committee recommended that the full commission hear the proposition by Canterbury Park.

**Agenda Item 6 – Action Items:**

**A. Election of Vice Chair and Second Vice Chair**

Chair McArdle introduced the item and Ms. Briner informed the commission that there was a written supplement to the meeting materials. Motion by Dehn for officers to maintain their current role. Second by Colombo. Motion Passed.

**B. Committee Appointments**

Chair McArdle introduced this item and referenced the current list of committee appointees in the meeting materials. There was discussion on adding members to the various committees and several commissioners added their thoughts on this item. There was discussion on quorum thresholds and open meeting laws. Commissioners Dehn, Gingold, Johnson, Koob, Idelkope as well as Mr. Newton and Ms. Briner participated in the conversation. Motion to approve current committee structure by Dehn, the motion was seconded and passed.

**C. Class A License Land Amendment**

**D. Improvement and Modification of Facilities and Equipment**

Items C and D were covered together. Mr. Sampson and Mr. Offerman gave a comprehensive presentation covering the scope of the proposed project. The topics included noise levels, traffic, security, equine safety, parking, overlapping concert and race days, future development, improvements to the barns and training track, structural integrity in the elements, existing land developments and how the project furthers the goals of horse racing. Commissioners McArdle, Dehn, Johnson, Colombo as well as Mr. Newton participated in the discussion. Motion to remove a portion of the class A license facility in phases as requested by Canterbury Park on July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, and to approve the modifications, alterations and improvements submitted on that same date by Colombo and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Idelkope. Motion carried. Motion to approve the three contracts submitted on July 31<sup>st</sup>, 2022, related to the improvements by Johnson, second by Koob. Motion passed.

New Business – Informational Items:

**Agenda Item 7 Staff Reports**

**A. Chief Veterinarian**

Dr. Hovda gave this report. She spoke about staffing shortages and gave updates on HISA implementation, the equine drug testing laboratory search for 2023, aftercare and racing. Commissioner Colombo asked about equine fatalities and Dr. Hovda responded with the public information and spoke about veterinary processes and track surfaces.

**B. Stewards**

Mr. Blaseg was absent, and Ms. Briner stated the report was in the meeting materials.

**C. Judges**

Mr. Corey gave this report. Chair McArdle and Mr. Corey discussed rulings, judges' daily reports and driver safety.

## Board of Stewards Report – Canterbury Park – August 2022

As you will see, wind and rain had a greater impact on racing than anything else in August. The live horse racing program on Saturday, August 6<sup>th</sup> was canceled after the 3<sup>rd</sup> race due when the riders reported to racetrack management that the track was unsafe after heavy rain. The entire program was canceled on Sunday, August 7<sup>th</sup>, after the riders and racetrack management decided mid-morning that the track was still unsafe for racing.


There was a long weather delay after the 5<sup>th</sup> race on Sunday, August 14<sup>th</sup> due to lightning in the area, and the final race of the program on Saturday, August 20<sup>th</sup> was delayed when the lights at the ¼ pole failed.

The Board of Stewards have issued 36 MRC rulings and 7 HISA rulings.

167 total claims with a total amount of \$1,762,000 in claiming value as of Sep. 4<sup>th</sup>.

## **JUDGES REPORT – RUNNING ACES – AUGUST 2022**

The month of August has come and gone as we head down the stretch of the 2022 harness racing meet here at Running Aces.

The judges issued 10 rulings in August, bringing the season total to 70. Since the exclusion of a licensee in mid-July, the number of rulings issued has diminished considerably.

In addition, there was a major suspension issued to a trainer as needles, syringes and injectables were found in his possession after the judges suggested a search by our MRC investigator. That trainer was given a 60-day suspension and a \$1,000 fine.

The new whips the judges implemented this meet continue to be an effective deterrent in minimizing the misuse of the whip during the running of the races.

The entry box has remained decent with 70 – 90 horses entered each draw day which allows Running Aces to program 9 or 10 races per program.

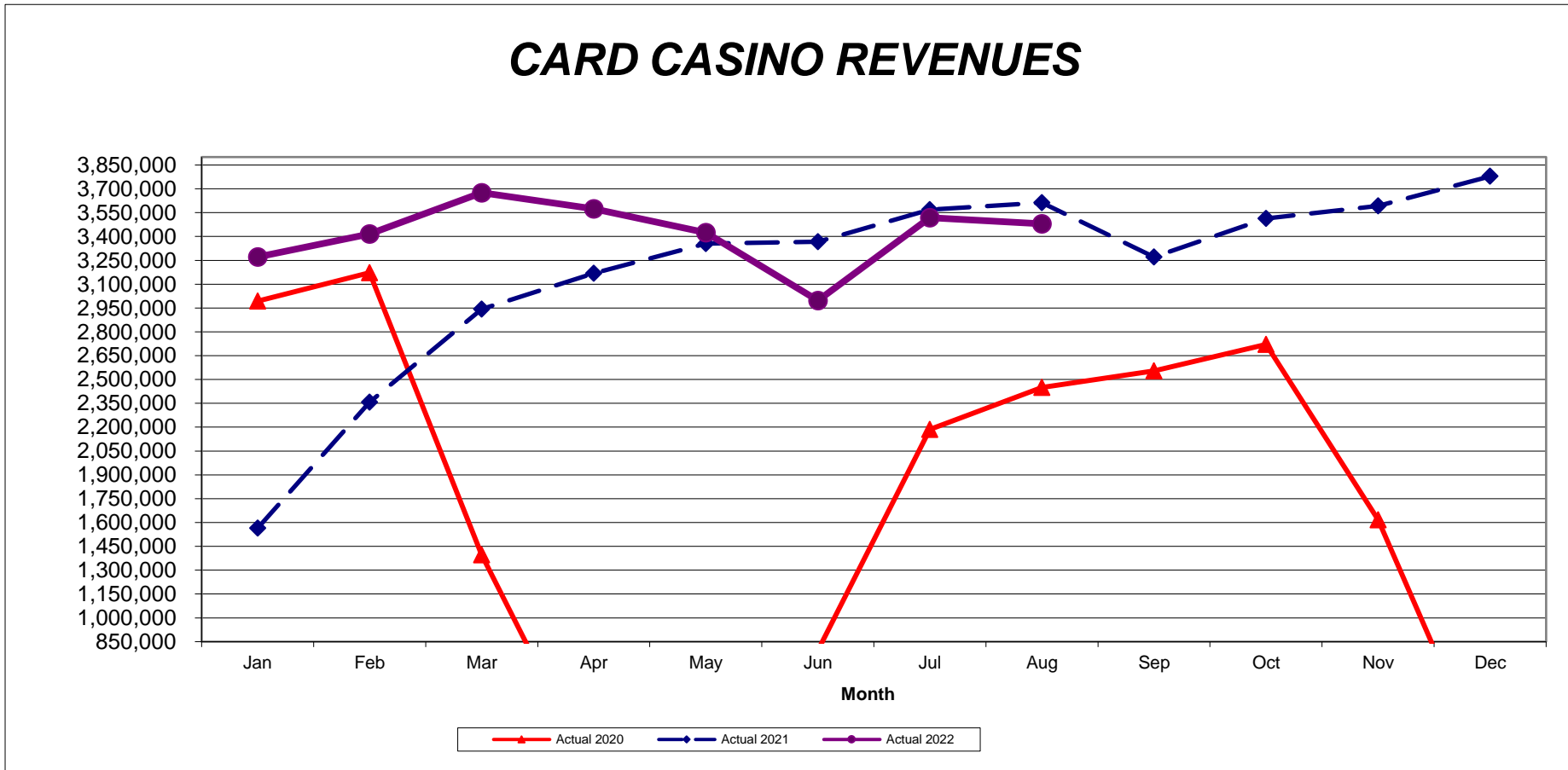

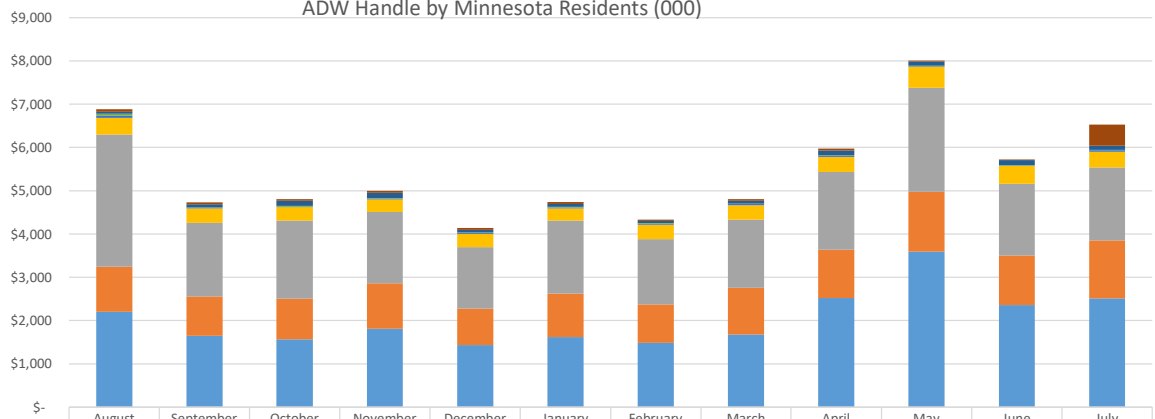
