Hello,

Yesterday afternoon I received the email below which prompted me to look at the agenda and read the stakeholders memo.

Please consider my response.

I support the following proposals in the Criminal Justice Stakeholders Memo dated August 3, 2018:

1. Ending Custody Status upon Discharge from Probation - Offenders who are discharged from probation should not continue to receive a CSP when they are no longer under custody supervision.
2. An offender's custody status with respect to a prior offense for which they are on supervision should not contribute more to criminal history than the actual commission of that offense.
3. The idea that the 15-year period of decay would start at the date of sentence, for offenders placed on probation. (For offenders who receive prison sentences, decay would continue to start at the date of discharge.)
4. The idea to eliminate, for all offenders, the criminal history point(s) that results from a sufficient number of prior gross misdemeanors and targeted misdemeanors.
