Notice of Public Hearing to Consider Amendments to the Sentencing Guidelines and Commentary

THE MINNESOTA SENTENCING GUIDELINES COMMISSION WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING on Thursday, July 16, 2020, at 1:30 p.m.

The public hearing is being held to consider proposed modifications to the 2019 Minnesota Sentencing Guidelines and Commentary resulting from legislative action and non-legislative amendments. A complete copy of the proposed amendments, as well as a more detailed description of their nature and effect, will be posted on the Commission's web site at mn.gov/sentencing-guidelines from June 15 through July 16, 2020. Information on how to attend the public hearing is also posted on the same web site.

The Commission will hold the record open for five calendar days after the public hearing to accept written comment.

Modifications are subject to final adoption by the Commission at its meeting on July 23, 2020. If adopted, modifications will take effect August 1, 2020, and will apply to crimes committed on or after that date.
