**ORDER ON REVIEW
OF ADDITIONAL NOTICE
PLAN AND DUAL NOTICE**

This matter came before Administrative Law Judge LauraSue Schlatter upon the Minnesota State Arts Board's request for a legal review under Minn. R. 1400.2060, .2080 (2015) of the Additional Notice Plan and Dual Notice of Intent to Adopt Rules in the above-captioned proceeding.

Under its Additional Notice Plan, the Board plans to notify the:

- a) Governor's office;
- b) chairs and ranking minority members of the legislative committees that oversee the Arts Board and Legacy funds;
- c) a list of 18,596 people or organizations who signed up to receive rulemaking information or applied to the Arts Board for funding;
- d) eleven regional arts councils; and
- e) 417 newspaper, radio, television, magazine and electronic news organizations located throughout the state of Minnesota via news releases.

Based upon a review of the written submissions by the Board,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. The Additional Notice Plan is **APPROVED** contingent upon the following additions, if not already included in item c), above:
 - a. Notice to school districts, charter schools and private elementary and secondary schools in the state, either individually by school or through appropriate school associations;

- b. Notice to public and private colleges and universities in the state, either individually or through appropriate college and university associations.

2. The Dual Notice is **APPROVED** contingent upon the following revision to the text of the Notice:

- (a) The date of the hearing is changed to October 27, 2015.
- (b) The reference to the statutory authority for this rulemaking in the section entitled "Subject of Rules and Statutory Authority" is revised to *Minnesota statutes*, section 129D.04, subdivision 1.
- (c) The fax number in the paragraph entitled "Notice of Hearing" is revised to: (651) 539-0310.
