In the Matter of Mohamed El Deeb, D.D.S. **FIRST PREHEARING ORDER**
License No. D9508

A prehearing conference was held in the above-captioned matter by telephone on May 30, 2006. Rosellen Condon and Sebastian Stewart, Assistant Attorneys General, 445 Minnesota Street, Suite 1400, St. Paul, MN 55101-2131, appeared on behalf of the Board of Dentistry Complaint Committee ("the Committee"). Richard A. Lind, Attorney at Law, Lind, Jensen, Sullivan & Peterson, P.A., 150 South Fifth Street, Suite 1700, Minneapolis, MN 55402-4217, appeared on behalf of Mohamed El Deeb, D.D.S.

Based upon discussions with counsel during the prehearing conference, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:

1. By July 3, 2006, the parties shall serve each other with initial statements identifying persons they expect to call as expert witnesses in this matter and, by August 8, 2006, the parties shall serve each other with supplemental statements identifying any additional experts they expect to call. These statements shall describe the subject matter of the expected testimony, state the substance of facts and opinions to which the expert is expected to testify, and provide a summary of the grounds for each opinion.
2. All discovery in this matter shall be completed by October 9, 2006.
3. All motions shall be served and filed by October 16, 2006. Responses in opposition to such motions shall be served and filed by October 27, 2006, and reply briefs with respect to such motions shall be served and filed by November 3, 2006.
4. By November 22, 2006, counsel shall exchange proposed exhibit and witness lists. The witness lists shall include a brief summary of the expected testimony of each witness. To the extent possible, the parties shall enter into prehearing stipulations regarding the facts involved in the hearing and foundation for anticipated exhibits.
5. By November 29, 2006, counsel shall notify the Administrative Law Judge whether they will require the services of a court reporter at the hearing. If no court reporter is requested, the hearing will be tape-recorded.

6. The hearing in this matter shall be held on December 13 – 15, 2006, commencing at 9:30 a.m. each day in the courtrooms of the Office of Administrative Hearings, 100 Washington Avenue South, Suite 1700, Minneapolis, Minnesota.
7. The parties shall appear at the hearing with at least three copies of each exhibit they plan to offer into evidence. Exhibits shall be pre-marked using Arabic numbers without designation of the party offering the exhibit.
