SCHEDULING ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

1. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, April 21, 2010**, each party will file and serve copies of the pre-labeled exhibits that it proposes to offer into the hearing record. The Department shall label its exhibits sequentially using numbers. Respondent shall label his exhibits sequentially using letters.
2. By 4:30 p.m. on **Wednesday, April 21, 2010**, each party will file and serve a list of witnesses that it intends to call at the evidentiary hearing, along with a short summary of the anticipated testimony of their witness (es).
3. By 4:30 p.m. on **Monday, April 26, 2010**, the parties will file and serve a statement (under Minn. R. 1400.6950 (2)) detailing any objection to the foundation of a written exhibit.
4. A hearing in this matter will be held at the St. Paul office of the Office of Administrative Hearings, 600 Robert Street North, St. Paul, MN 55164 on **Thursday, April 29, 2010**, beginning at 9:30 a.m.
