SECOND PREHEARING ORDER

Following the written submissions of the parties, and the further argument of counsel during a January 4, 2008 telephone conference;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

By 4:30 p.m. on **Tuesday, January 15, 2008**, the Department of Human Rights shall:

1. Submit for an *in camera* review by the undersigned those portions of its investigative file that are otherwise responsive to:
 - a. The City's Interrogatories Number 3, 4, 13, 14 and 16; and,
 - b. The City's Request for the Production of Documents Number 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 8, 9 and 10.
2. Detail – either by designating in the document, submitting a separate privilege log or transmitting some other writing – the investigative methods that are deserving of protection against disclosure.
3. File with this Office and serve upon counsel a draft protective order that, in the Commissioner's view, would permit the City's discovery of relevant information while safeguarding against the disclosure of the agency's investigative methods and techniques.
